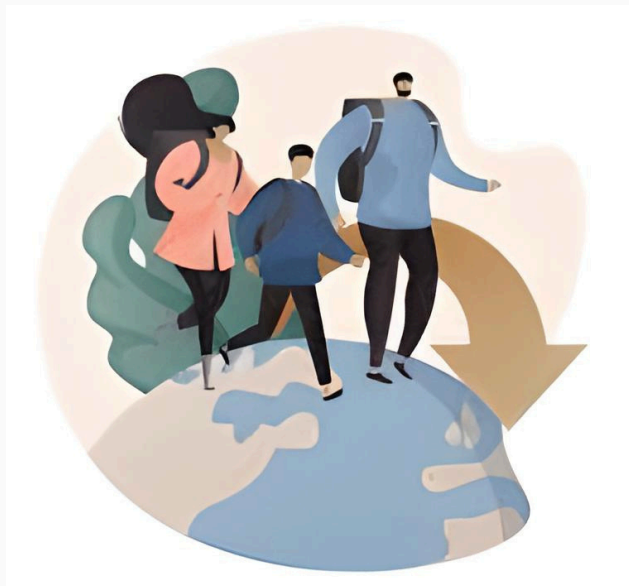


WHAT IS SIRIUS INTERNATIONAL ?

SIRIUS is a European network bringing together institutions, universities, NGOs and advocacy groups committed to providing access to education for migrants throughout Europe. The network facilitates the development of inclusive policies and actions by exchanging knowledge and experiences among researchers, practitioners, youth, immigrant communities, and policymakers to develop common strategies for migrant education.

At the National Level

The SIRIUS Montpellier France network is led by researchers from University Montpellier Paul-Valéry, members of the LHUMAIN research unit. In connection with associative and institutional structures, it aims to weave sustainable relationships between formal, informal, and non-formal education.

Our vision ?

Our ultimate goal is to work towards the creation and dissemination of pedagogical and political tools and approaches that draw on the cultural and multilingual resources of the various stakeholders in the network

How ?

- Implementation of a resource platform to link different educational structures.
- Implementation of inclusive actions (within the city, between institutions, with families...).
- Information for and by newly arrived student's families in different languages, both orally and in writing.

What is a "Learning Territory"?

At the local level, the SIRIUS network is rooted in "learning territories" open to young migrants and their families. This model was first built in the Figuerolles district of Montpellier. It is now expanding to the scale of the Montpellier-Méditerranée Metropolis and can also be exported to other territories in Occitanie or across France.

The goal is to branch out actions offered within the same territory for young migrants and their families into coherent and complementary pathways. This requires weaving strong links between formal, non-formal, and informal education structures, and working together on the challenges of French language learning, multilingualism, and intercultural exchange.



Each petal represents a neighborhood partner (school, association, museum, social center, community center...) participating in co-education.

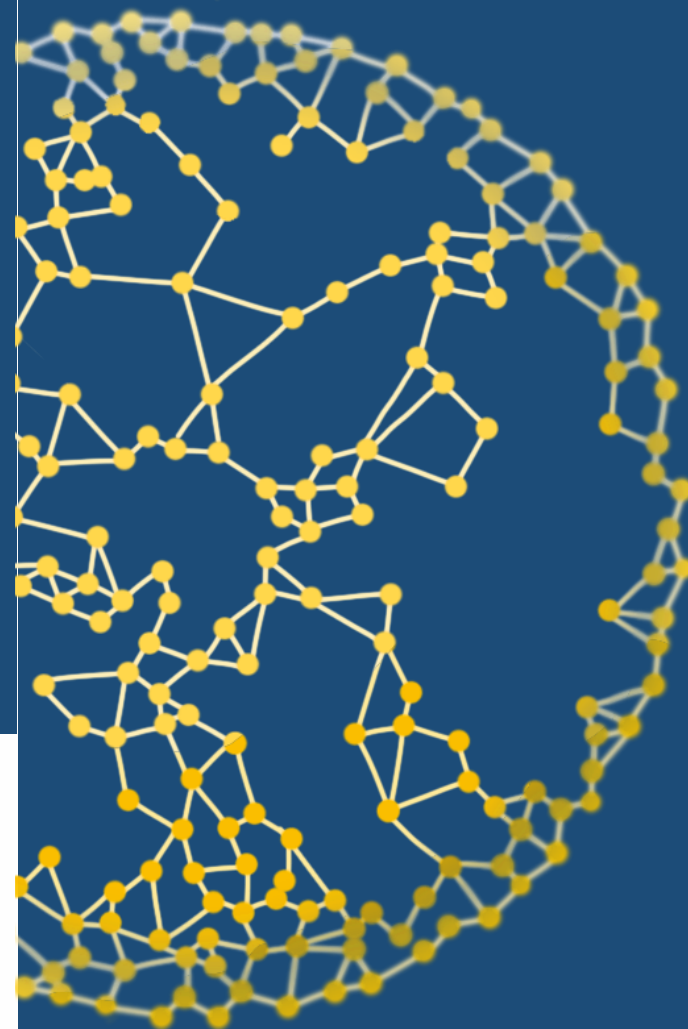
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
